This year's annual Posada (Christmas celebration) in the prison was an opportunity to share God's love with 350 prisoners and some of the prison guards. 30 some volunteers, including four pastors, gathered outside the prison walls to pray, inviting God's presence and asking for protection for all the day's activities and participants. We entered with the meal (a huge pot of Birria (shredded meat), chile meat sauce, refried beans, tortillas, pies, coffee and juice), sound equipment, and gifts for the prisoners. Two pastors came from out of town to speak with the prisoners. They started with some easy-to-sing praise songs and shared the reason they were there. Each of the speaking pastors is a former convict who has since dedicated his life

to sharing his story and the message of God's grace with prisoners. Next, two dramas were shared from the stage. One was entirely put on by prisoners, men and women from the weekly Bible Studies. It was excellent and a wonderful opportunity for the Christians to work together to put on this drama.



Pastor Jesse then shared his testimony and God's simple message...

The Creator of the universe sent <u>His Son</u> to live here on earth as a human...for them. It is because of His great love for them that Jesus came and He has a wonderful purpose for each of them. Simply accept what He has done for you, repent of trying to 'do it yourself' and humbly allow His grace to guide you in the path of trusting Him. Amen!
