Blessings shared in December 2009

In addition to the listed donated items (see page 2), Manos de Dios provided much needed personal items such as **Christmas gifts** to the men and women in the prison, pastor's wives and friends. New blankets and hoodie sweatshirts were donated and we shared them with the small churches in El Diamante and Desemboque. They were delighted, saying they had never received donations for their community other than used items.

A hospital in Texas shipped 27 boxes of excess medical supplies to Manos de Dios last fall. We were able to bring them to Mexico (paying some import fees) to help out doctors who serve the needy in two communities. What a blessing to help people with medical needs that can't afford to purchase needed supplies.

For the third year, a hospital supply company donated hundreds of gently

used blankets, sheets and pillow cases to Manos de Dios. These blankets are 'priceless' to those who are cold on winter nights! The sheets are covering mattresses in the prison and rehab centers. Besides being used on pillows, the pillow cases are used as laundry bags and for craft projects in the rehab center.
