Our "Hands of God" ministry home in the White Mountains of Arizona!



She has been enrolled in boarding schools and is now ready to come to Tucson and attend Desert Christian High School. Her sister, Riscilla, has attended Desert this year and has shared with Drelyn the benefits of moving to Tucson.

This host family needs to be open to the Native American culture that Drelyn brings with her. Patience will be needed as all adjust to life together. Here's an example from something I learned as her dorm parent. When I asked Drelyn to do something, I left her alone. Then, she would do whatever it was and usually do it very well. (If I stayed to watch her do it, she delayed doing whatever it was!)

Drelyn is a wonderful young lady and God has a plan to use her in a powerful way for His Kingdom!

Thearsa likes basketball, swimming & reading. She loves her family very much. She struggles some academically, specifically in math and spelling. She may need some extra help in her class work. She has attended American Indian Christian Mission School for the past two years. Thearsa has experienced some depression in the past. She will need a patient, understanding family.

Her mother, Yosh, would love to move to Tucson some day. She would like her daughters, Thearsa and Naomi to come to Desert Christian School this next school year to be in a high-quality Christian school and a safe community. *Naomi and Thearsa need to be in the same host family home*.





Naomi is a fun-loving, pleasant young lady. She enjoys activities and crafts. She likes to read her Bible and pray. She also has a heart for lost people in the world.

Naomi has attended American Indian Christian Mission School for the past two years. She and her mom agree that it is time for her to move to Tucson to benefit from the high-quality education at Desert Christian School. She will certainly grow and bloom in this environment. *Thearsa and Naomi need to be in the same host family home*.

My husband, Dan, volunteered at AICM for a weekend last March. When he came home, he asked if I would be interested in hosting 1 or 2 girls from the Apache reservation. I was surprised and also very excited. We briefly



met Jacy in June, and then for a week in July. When we met her, we knew she would fit into our home. She moved here in August to start school at Desert Christian Middle School.

It was an adjustment for all of us, especially Jacy. It took a lot of courage and faith in God to move here. Everything was brand new to her; this home, host parents, school, friends, community, activities within her school and outside her school, and even the type of food. For Dan and me, we haven't had kids live with us before, so getting used to a 13-year-old and her activities was different, but good. Plus, we have never been involved with a middle school, school athletics programs, and figuring out homework schedules.

Over the months, Dan and I have been having a wonderful experience with Jacy living with us. She adapts well to new situations, she can make new friends easily, and she has a strong determination. We are all learning each others' likes and dislikes, personalities, and strengths and weaknesses. Plus, we've really enjoyed getting to know Lucy, Dennis, Rena, Miranda (the other host family), and Riscilla, along with some of Jacy's family. Dennis and Lucy have gone above and beyond what I expected. They try to attend as many sports events as they can, they do things with the girls from time to time, plus they are always there for questions, comments or just helping us put some of the pieces of the puzzle together. We can all see God at work in this situation. He put Jacy in our lives, and we are so thankful for this experience!


The girls and their host families share a lot of time together.

Host family criteria


Here is a partial list of characteristics that are necessary for host families.

- Able to set and follow through with reasonable guidelines for student
- Available and willing to assist with organizing and completing homework
- Willing to communicate with Dennis & Lucy and the student's family





- That God would lead us as we plan youth activities and disciple-making for this summer.






